Dear Harrington Park Families,

When we returned to school in January after our holiday break, an extensive number of families contacted the school to report either being exposed to or testing positive for COVID. Coupled with the unexpected sudden change in COVID guidance, many families required assistance on the Monday after break to review the timeline and discuss the next steps for their child. These events put a strain on the Main Office and Health Office to coordinate that information prior to the start of the school day. As we look towards the February break and the continued instability of information from the State of New Jersey, we have decided that:

Monday, February 28th, we will have a delayed opening for students with a reporting time of 10:00 a.m. Staff will report to the facility at their normal entry time.

With many of our families traveling over the February break and COVID still a presence in our lives, this delayed opening will allow the Health Office and Administration the ability to contact parents and for our staff to prepare for the week ahead in the event some of our students need to move to a virtual learning platform.

This will allow for a calm and purposeful entry back to school for our students, staff and families. We thank you for your cooperation and continued support.
