Good Evening Family Members,

As you might be aware, Bergen County operates numerous schools throughout the county (Bergen County Technical, Bergen County Academies, Bergen County Special Services, etc.) in which students are transported from communities throughout Bergen County. Due to the geographic area that this district serves, the county health department has asked that students not to report to school beginning on Wednesday, March 11th. Please be advised that currently there are no reported cases of COLVIN -19 in the Bergen County Tech/Special Services district as of the writing of this update.

The Harrington Park School District has been meeting with both our local and district health coordinators to obtain the current guidance, analyze our risks, and assess the proactive measures necessary to keep school open. At this time, there are no confirmed cases inside the Harrington Park Community, thus we can continue to conduct normal operations. We will continue to consult with various health care professionals and we will keep you apprised of any new developments.

I ask that we take a few minutes, as a family, to discuss with our children that their safety is our utmost concern and everyone is working hard to keep them safe. I would also like to thank everyone as a community for their hard work during this very difficult time.
